

# User Information

## Protect Yourself!

Always wear eye, ear, respiratory and body protection. Unplug before fitting. If in doubt about suitable personal protective equipment, you must consult an industrial safety specialist. Tie back long hair and secure or remove loose clothing as they might get caught in the machine. Exposure to wood dust should be prevented, or where this is not reasonably practicable, adequately controlled, (H&S.E). Keep work area clear of people and flammable material. Never remove guards from machine. Read power tool manufacturer's manual for fitting instructions and to ensure suitability; do not mount onto makeshift apparatus, the belt must be mounted onto the machine it was intended for.

## Dangers Of!

Wood dust explosion/Wood dust fire/Slipping/Skin disorders/Nasal obstructions/Rhinitis/Rare type of nasal cancer/Asthma

## Examination, Storage & Handling!

Upack and examine; reject damaged or torn belts. Handle with care. Store in dry conditions away from direct sunlight. Do not expose to hot, cold or damp conditions.

## Mounting The Belt!

Mount the belt with the arrow pointing in the direction of the machine rotation.
